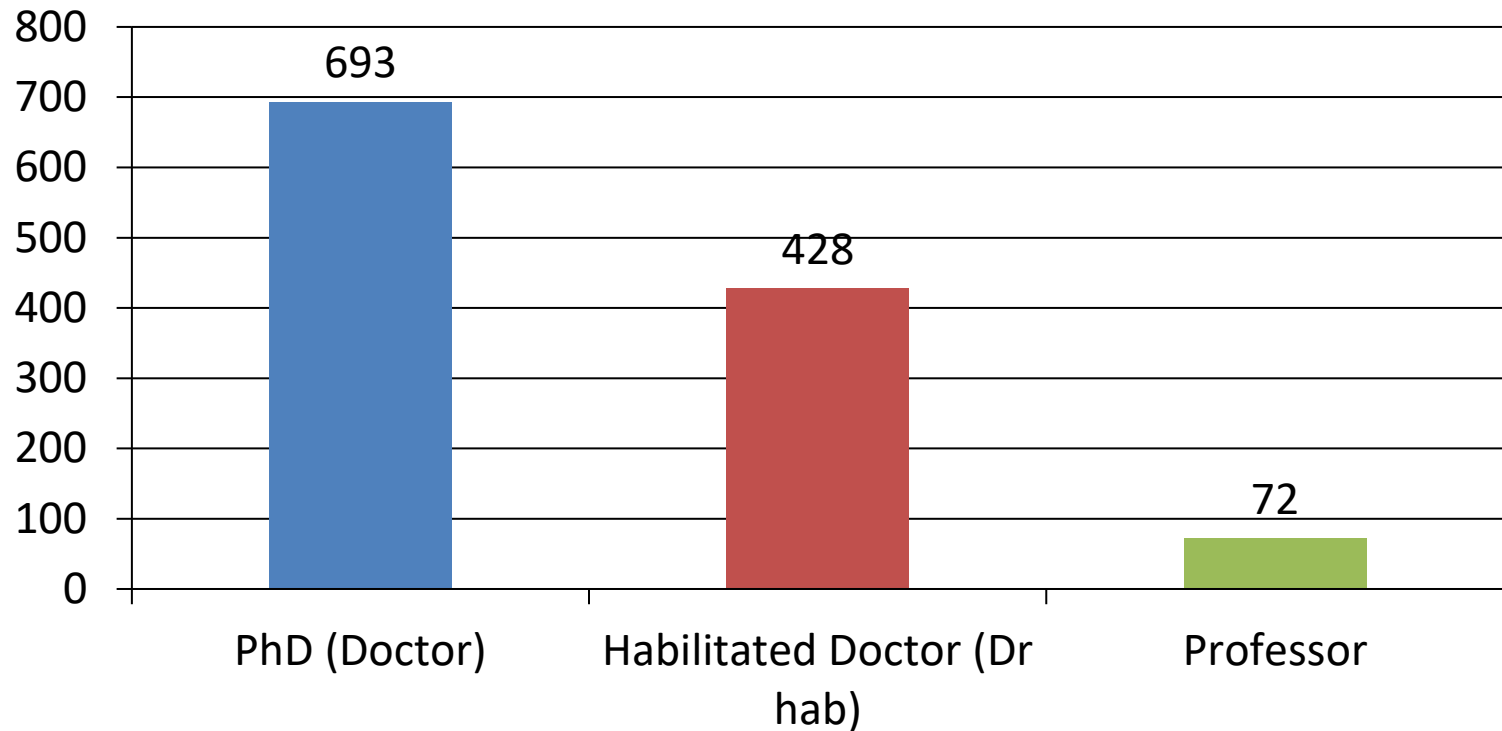

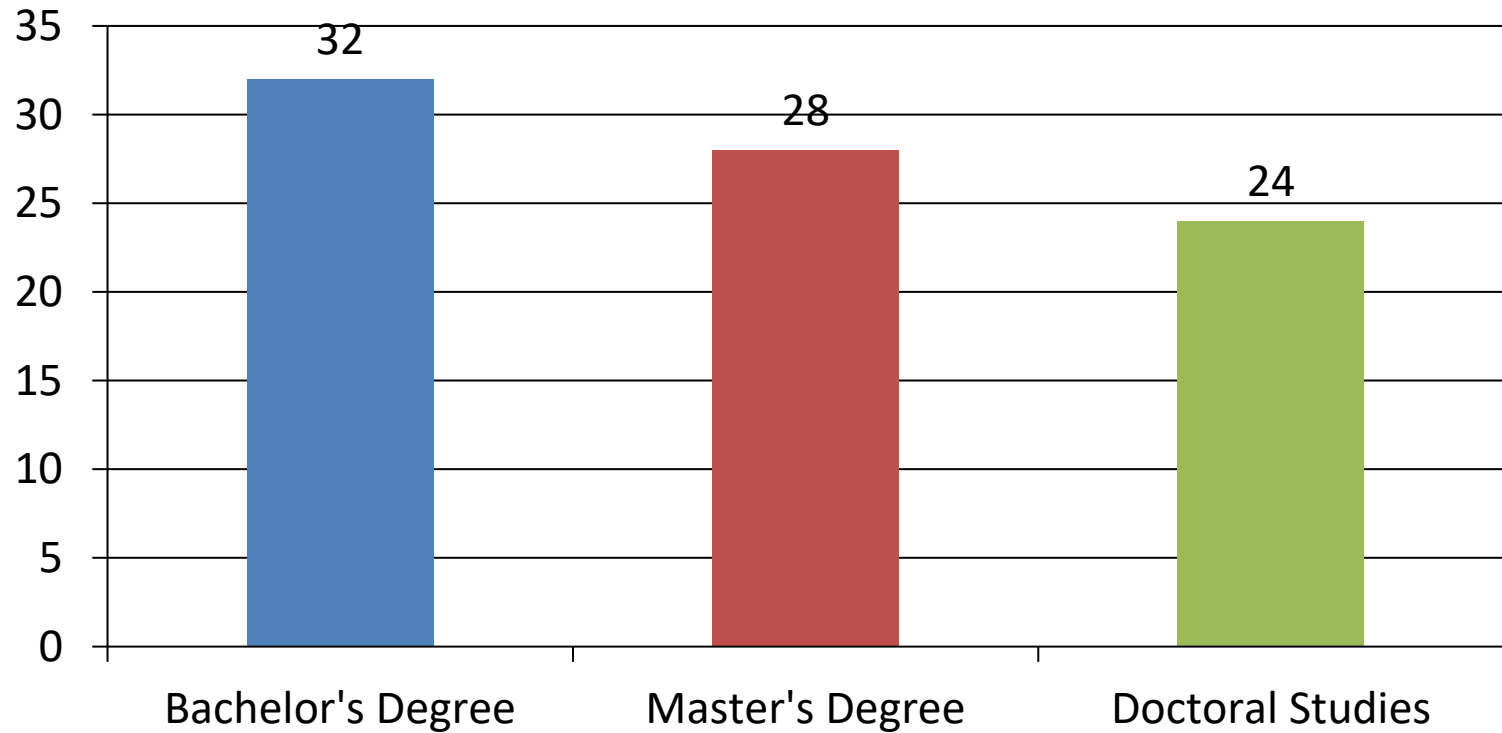

Number of Employees



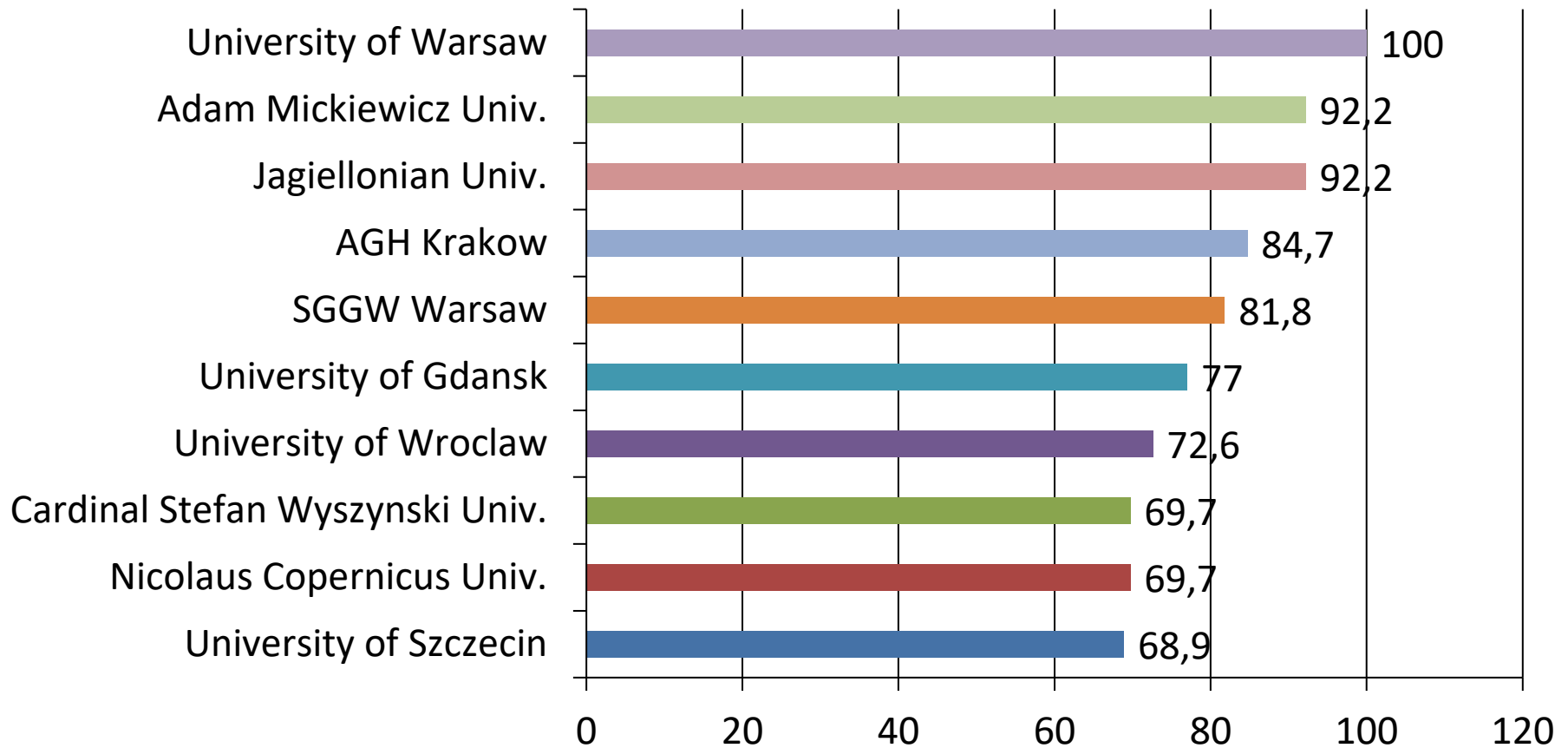
Universities by Level of Studies Offered

Number of Universities

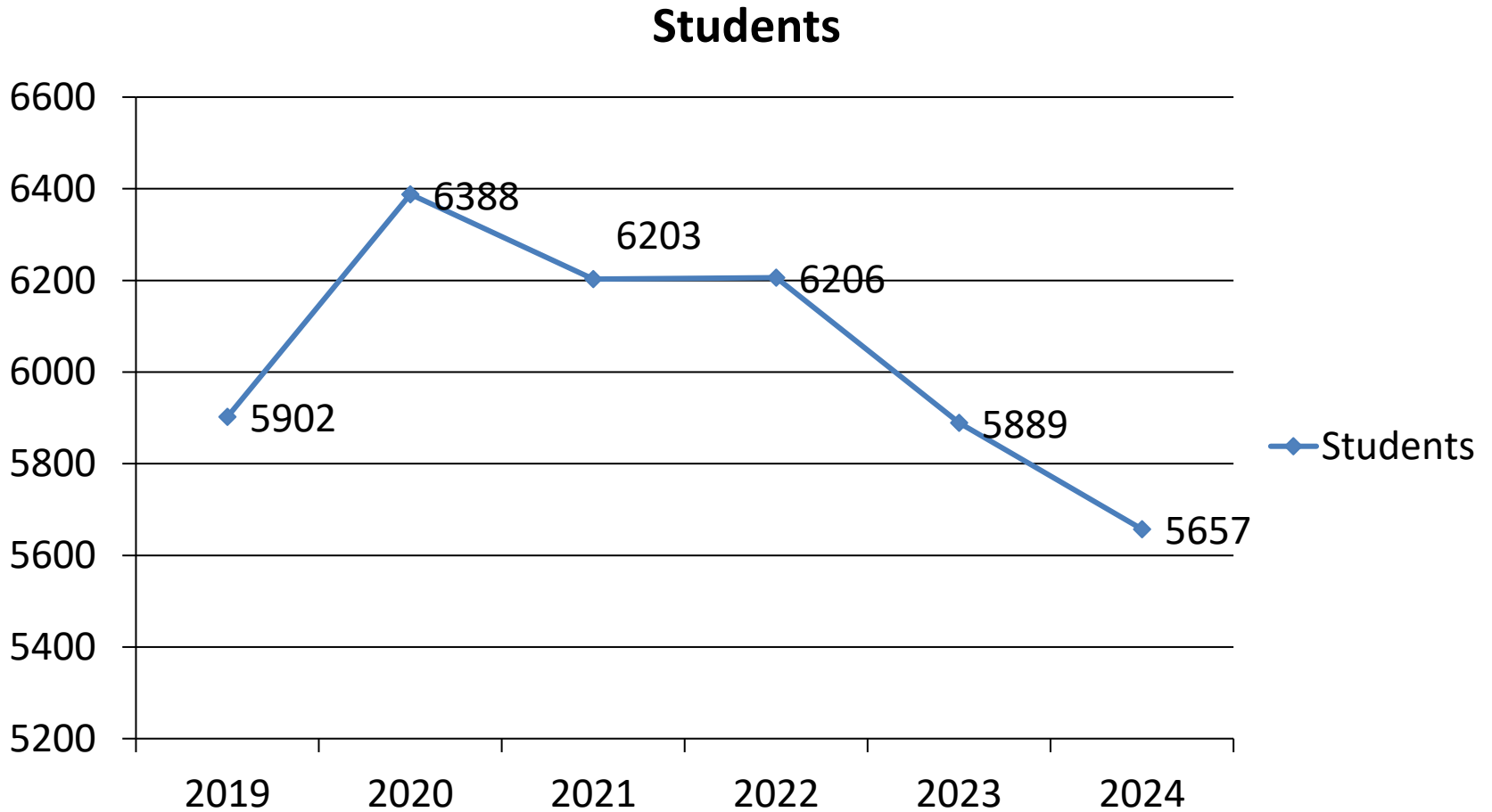


Top 10 Sociology Programs in Poland (Ranking „Perspektywy”)

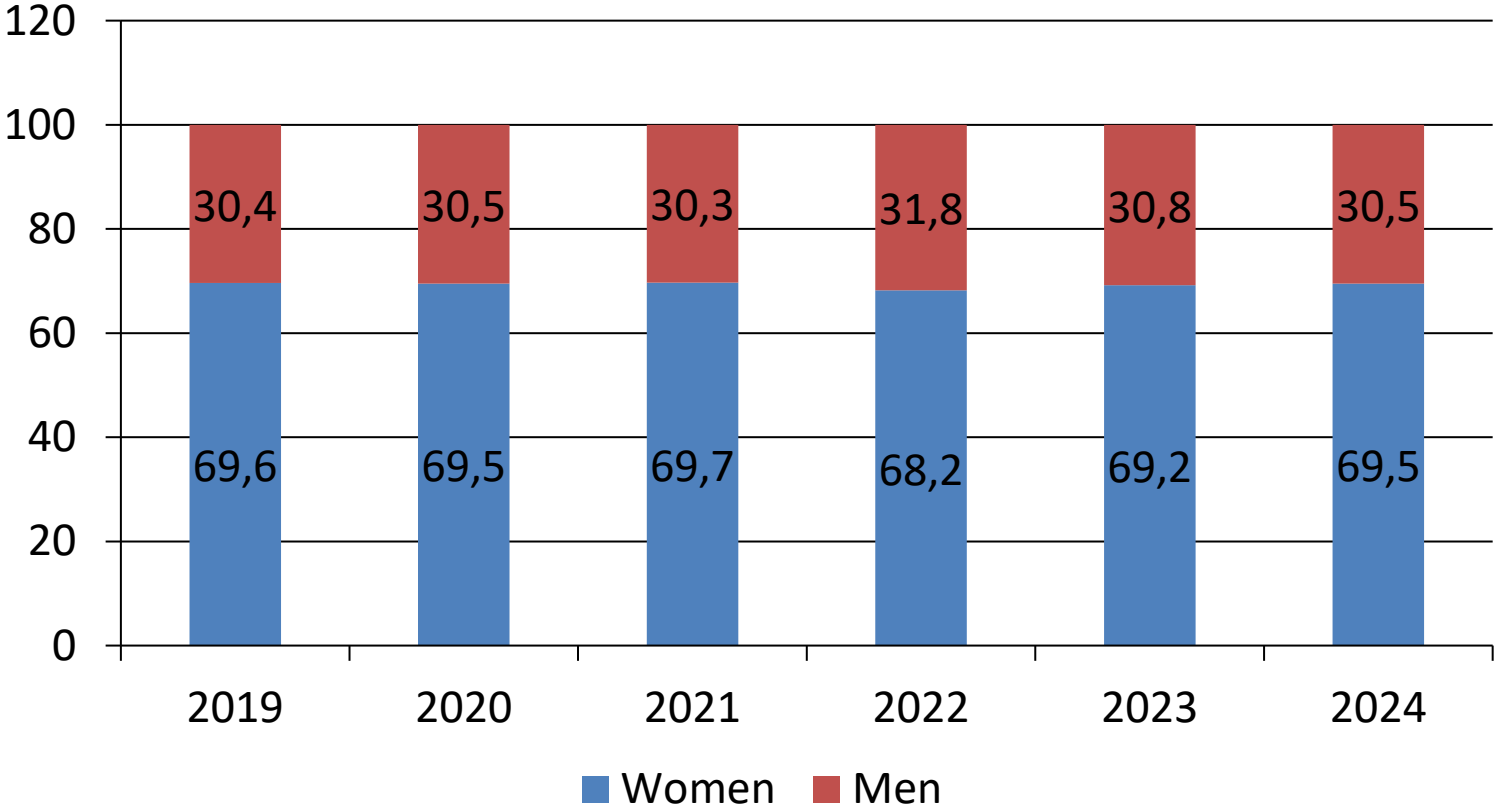

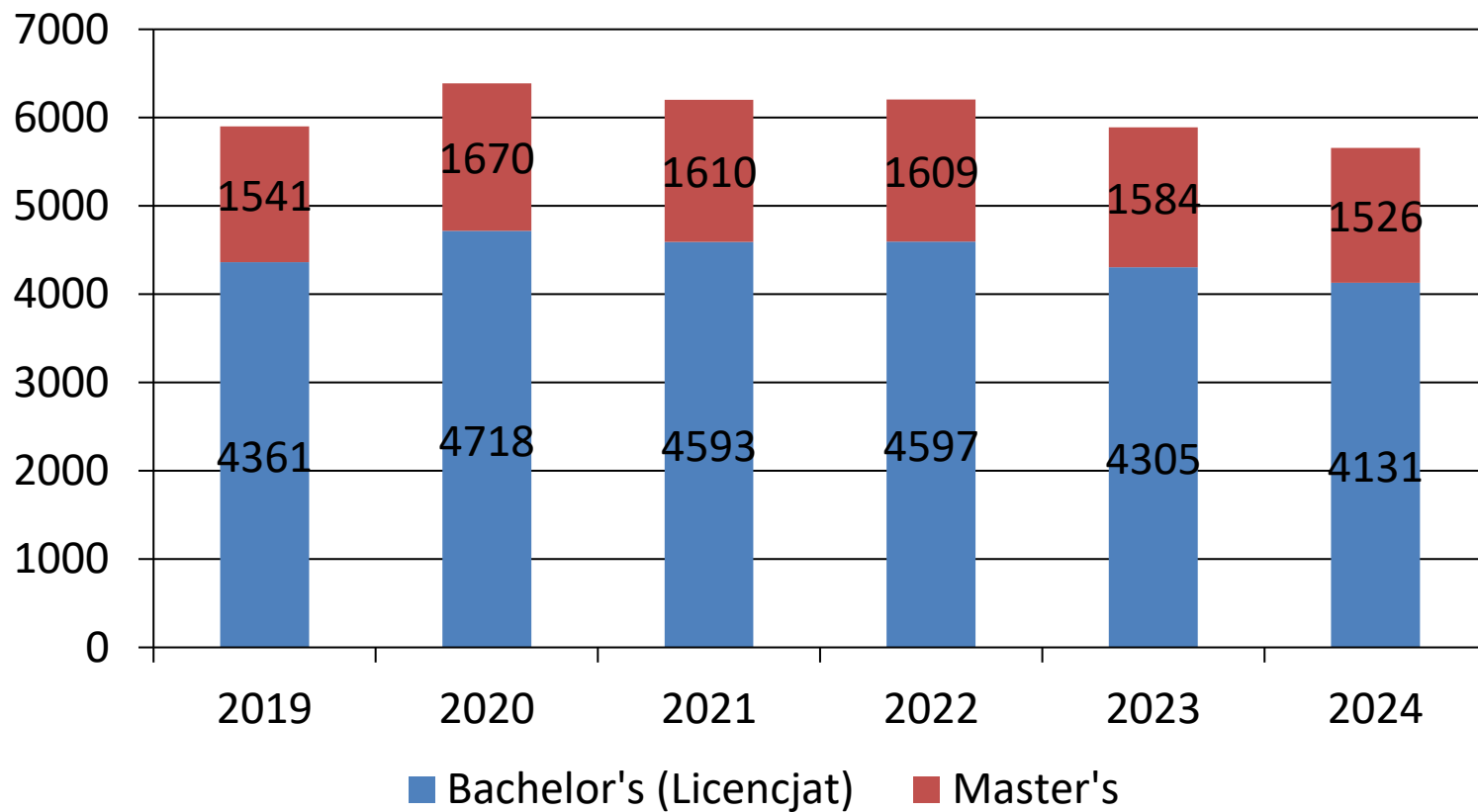
Student Trend of Sociology (2019–2024)



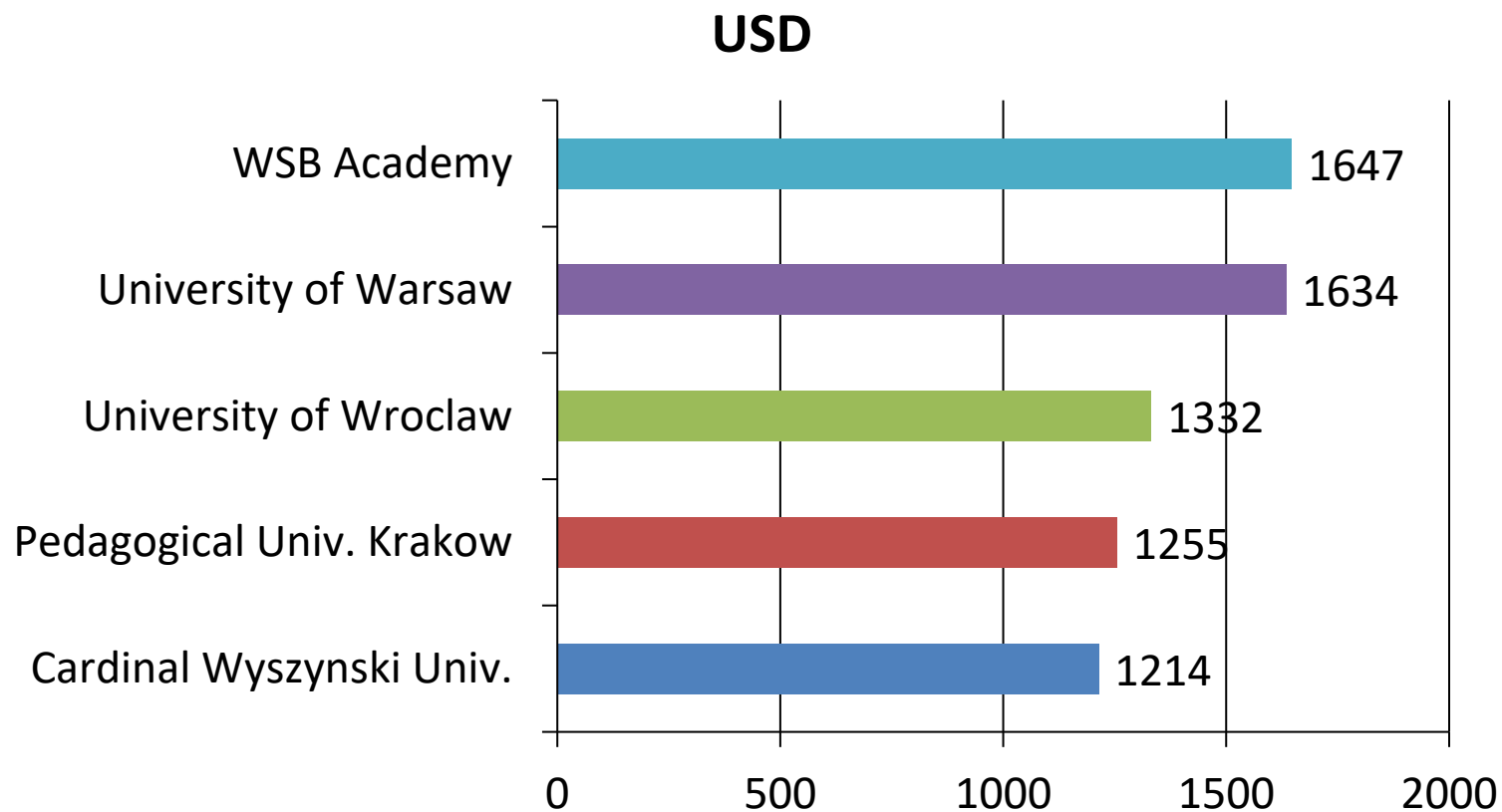
Students by Gender (%) (2019–2024)



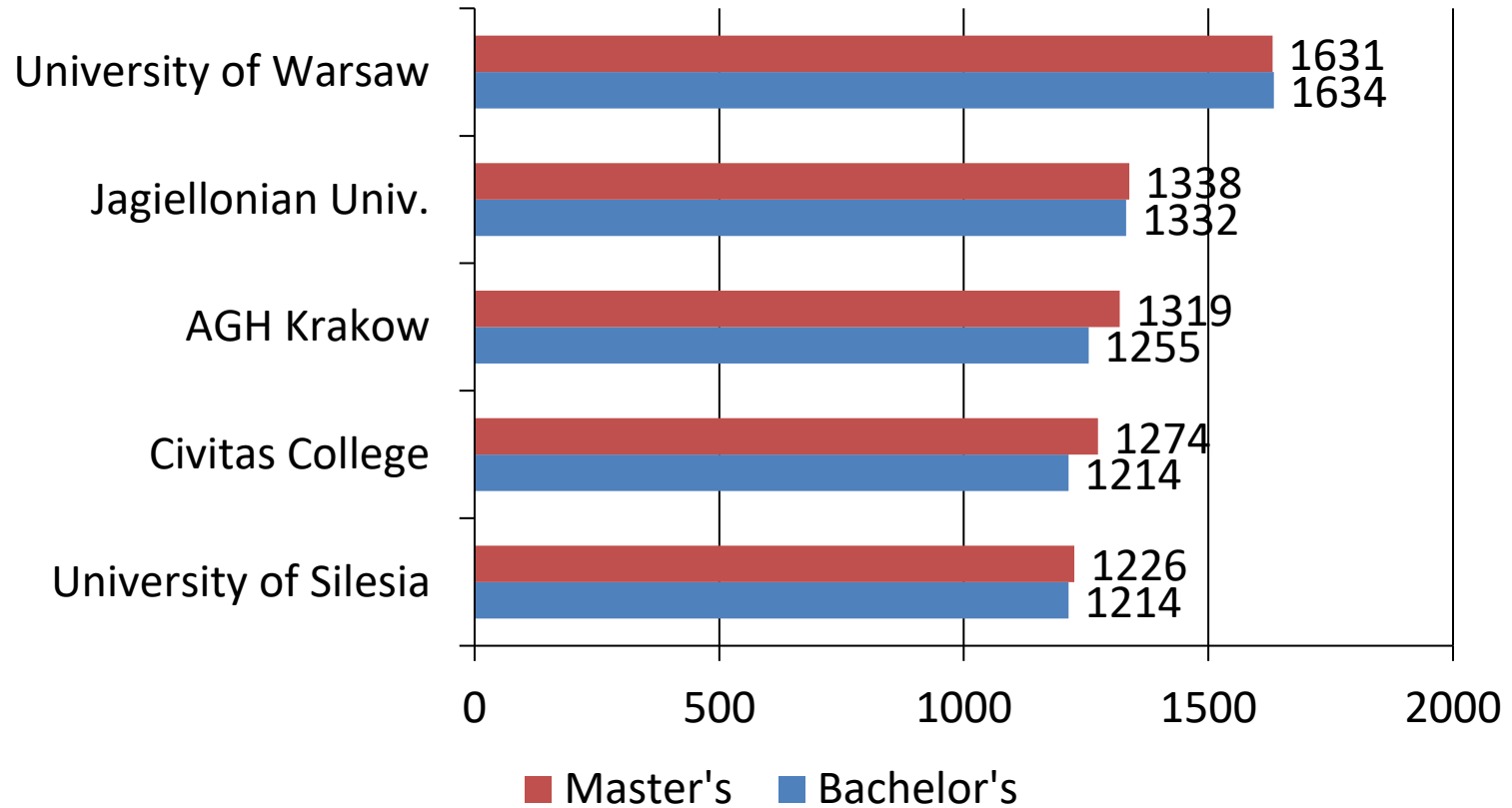
Students by Study Level (Bachelor vs Master)
